January 15: Abstracts in a Presidential Plenary receive their PAS acceptance email.

January 17: All Plenary Information COMPLETE in Cadmium with ALL speakers listed.

NOTE: If you do not complete your Plenary information by the January 17 deadline, it may not be visible to the public for the January 31 Online Program Guide Launch.

January 24: Plenary Speakers receive a PAS speaker invitation. Cadmium email will notify speakers of due dates for COI, slides, pre-recordings, and other requirements.

January 27: M6 reviews the Online Program Guide before launch on January 31.

January 31: Online Program Guide launches with all Presidential Plenary details.
